Varvara Nepomnyashchaya is a pianist who employs her musical intelligence in order to present a faithful interpretation of the works of great composers. With determination, energy and honesty she makes every concert an unforgettable artistic experience. Her rich repertoire includes almost all periods and styles, from Bach and Händel to Stravinsky and Arvo Pärt.

Born in Moscow, Russia, Varvara studied at the Gnessin State Musical College and continued her studies at the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory with Mikhail Voskressensky. She later moved to Hamburg for further study with Evgeni Koroliov. In 2006 she was awarded at the Leipzig Bach Competition and in 2012 she was launched onto the international scene after winning the first Prize of the Concours Géza Anda in Zurich.

Varvara has quickly established a remarkable musical reputation performing with many of the world's most prestigious orchestras including Mariinsky Theatre Orchestra, Vienna Chamber Orchestra, Tonhalle Orchester Zürich, Vienna Radio Symphony Orchestra, The Jenaer Philharmonie and Stuttgart Radio Symphony Orchestra, performing under the baton of Valery Gergiev, David Zinman, Cornelius Meister and Clemens Schuldt. As a recitalist, she has offered numerous Recitals in Lucerne, Madrid, Moscow, Lyon, Saint Petersburg, Hamburg, Lausanne, Zurich and Dortmund, among others.

In the 2016/2017 season Varvara performs with orchestras including Mariinsky Theatre Orchestra, Tchaikovsky Symphony Orchestra, Gulbenkian Orchestra, Lille National Orchestra and Oviedo Filarmonía. As a recitalist, highlights of this season and beyond include performances at the Sate Musicali in Milan, Mariinsky Theatre in Saint Petersburg, Louisiana Museum in Humlebæk, Rudolfinum in Prague, Philharmonie de Paris, a debut on the Saint-Denis Festival 2017.

Varvara is currently working on her new recording that features works by W.A. Mozart, which is her second album after the collection of Suites by Händel produced by Discamera and available on iTunes, Spotify, Amazon and Google Play Music.
