VARVARA

Born in Moscow, Varvara studied at the Gnessin State Musical College and at the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory with Mikhail Voskressensky. She went on to study under the supervision of Evgeni Koroliov in Hamburg.

Awarded at the Leipzig Bach Competition (2006), Varvara then won the first Prize of the Concours Géza Anda in Zürich (2012) as a result of which she started her international career.

Recent engagements and future highlights in 2020-2021 see Varvara's debut at the Suntory Hall with Tokyo Symphony Orchestra with Jonathan Nott, performances in La Grande de Meslay (France), with the Orquesta Sinfonica de Galicia, Auditori of Barcelona, in Girona, Madrid's Juan March Fundación, Teatro Principal Alicante, Théâtre de la Ville, Paris, Tonhalle Zürich, and at the Liszt Academy Budapest. Subsequent concerts see Varvara perform with the Orquesta de Extremadura, the Tchaikovsky Symphony Orchestra (Moscow) and tours with Fumiaki Miura in Japan and with the Wiener Kammerorchester in Spain.

Varvara has quickly established a remarkable musical reputation by performing with many of world's most prestigious orchestras including Mariinsky Theatre, Wiener Kammerorchester, Tonhalle Zürich, SWR Sinfonieorchester, Hungarian Radio Symphony, Tchaikovsky Symphony Orchestra, Polish National Radio Symphony, Bilbao Symphony, Valencia Symphony, Galicia Symphony or Santiago de Chile Philharmonic, playing under the baton of Eliahu Inbal, Valery Gergiev, David Zinman, Cornelius Meister, Clemens Schuldt, Alexander Liebreich, Yaron Traub or Vladimir Fedoseyev. As a recitalist, she has offered numerous concerts at Lucerne Festival, Tonhalle Zürich, Auditorio Madrid, Conservatory Moscow, Philharmonie Paris, Palau de la Música Barcelona, Le Corum Montpellier, Conservatorio Verdi Milano, Auditorio Lingotto Torino, Auditorium Lyon, Mariinsky Theatre, Rudolfinum Prague, Mozarteum Salzburg and Konzerthaus Dortmund.

Curious about different musical styles, Varvara enjoys playing a wide range of the repertoire, including solo and chamber music. This enthusiasm in sharing music with others led to the creation of a Duo with violinist Fumiaki Miura, and a piano trio with Miura and cellist Jonathan Roozeman.

Varvara's discography includes a Mozart and a Handel, which both were praised by the press. Other releases include a Liszt CD, live recorded at the Philharmonie in Paris, all for the label Dis:Camera.
